A MOTION authorizing the county executive to apply for 1994-1995 Coordinated Prevention Grant funds in the approximate amount of \$1,392,909 to reimburse, in part, implementation costs of the Local Hazardous Waste Management Program in King County.

WHEREAS, King County is required by RCW 70.05.060 and 70.95.160, K.C.C. 10.24.040(E) and by the Solid Waste Interlocal Agreement to develop and implement a Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan, and

WHEREAS, WAC 173-312 provides for the award of Coordinated Prevention Grants by the Washington State Department of Ecology pursuant to RCW 70.105D.070(3) (the Model Toxics Control Act) to assist local governments with hazardous and solid waste management planning and program implementation, and

WHEREAS, Coordinated Prevention Grants are awarded to local governments (one every biennium, starting with the 1992-1993 biennium, with supplemental funds awarded mind-way through each biennium), and

WHEREAS, The King County council recognizes an obligation to provide approximately \$928,606 in matching funds through the Local Hazardous Waste Fund, and

WHEREAS, this match shall be met through 1994 and 1995 appropriated expenditure authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to apply to the Department of Ecology for approximately \$1,392,909 to reimburse, in part, the costs of implementing the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan in King County.
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
