2 A MOTION authorizing the county executive  
3 to apply for 1994-1995 Coordinated  
4 Prevention Grant funds in the approximate  
5 amount of \$1,392,909 to reimburse, in part,  
6 implementation costs of the Local Hazardous  
7 Waste Management Program in King County.

8 WHEREAS, King County is required by RCW 70.05.060 and  
9 70.95.160, K.C.C. 10.24.040(E) and by the Solid Waste  
10 Interlocal Agreement to develop and implement a Local Hazardous  
11 Waste Management Plan, and

12 WHEREAS, WAC 173-312 provides for the award of Coordinated  
13 Prevention Grants by the Washington State Department of Ecology  
14 pursuant to RCW 70.105D.070(3) (the Model Toxics Control Act)  
15 to assist local governments with hazardous and solid waste  
16 management planning and program implementation, and

17 WHEREAS, Coordinated Prevention Grants are awarded to local  
18 governments (one every biennium, starting with the 1992-1993  
19 biennium, with supplemental funds awarded mind-way through each  
20 biennium), and

21 WHEREAS, The King County council recognizes an obligation  
22 to provide approximately \$928,606 in matching funds through the  
23 Local Hazardous Waste Fund, and

24 WHEREAS, this match shall be met through 1994 and 1995  
25 appropriated expenditure authority;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

27 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to apply  
28 to the Department of Ecology for approximately \$1,392,909 to  
29 reimburse, in part, the costs of implementing the Local  
30 Hazardous Waste Management Plan in King County.

31 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to  
32 execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
