A MOTION requesting the executive to co-sponsor a grant application to the Puget Sound Water Quality Authority for a public involvement and education effort in conjunction with Waterways 2000.

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Water Quality Authority provides funds for public education efforts to improve water quality in Puget Sound, and

WHEREAS, King County has initiated a new pilot program called Waterways 2000 to preserve and enhance critical watersheds, and

WHEREAS, a key component of Waterways 2000 is to leverage other funds in order to maximize county resources, and

WHEREAS, the Northwest Car Wash Association and the Seattle/King County Land Conservancy are initiating a public awareness effort, in conjunction with the local media, to inform the public of the impacts resulting from untreated water pollutants, and

WHEREAS, King County will be undertaking a public education and involvement effort in conjunction with Waterways 2000, and

WHEREAS, the resources used by the County for its public involvement effort can be used as a match to the PIE grant, and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the public to coordinate efforts with this initiative within Waterways 2000 targeted watersheds in order to prevent the duplication of public outreach and education efforts, and

WHEREAS, successful PIE grant models involve "unlikely" partnerships such as industry, private non-profit organizations, and local government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: That the executive is requested to co-sponsor an application to the Puget Sound Water Quality Authority, in conjunction with

1 the Northwest Car Wash Association and the Seattle/King County  
2 Land Conservancy for a public involvement and education effort  
3 within targeted watersheds in coordination with Waterways 2000.
