

MOTION NO. 9263

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A MOTION authorizing the county executive to enter into an interlocal agreement with the city of Carnation relating to landmark designation and protection services.

WHEREAS, the city of Carnation desires to protect and preserve historic buildings, structures, districts, sites and objects within the city limits, and

WHEREAS, the county is interested in providing landmark designation and protection services to the city, consistent with the findings of Ordinance 10474, and

WHEREAS, the county is able and willing to provide the requested municipal services;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to execute an interlocal agreement, substantially in the form attached, with the city of Carnation for the county to provide landmark designation and protection services.
