A MOTION requesting that zoning at the Wilderness Lake Park site in the Tahoma/Raven Heights Communities Planning Area be set for a public hearing by Department of Parks, Planning and Resources, pursuant to K.C.C. 21.60.030.

WHEREAS, the 1984 Tahoma/Raven Heights Communities Plan applied SR 7200 zoning to the property located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Southeast 248th and Witte Road Southeast, and

WHEREAS, the King County parks division leased this site within Lake Wilderness Park to the Maple Valley Community Center initially to provide recreational programs for local residents, and

WHEREAS, a Maple Valley Community Center Task Force was formed to seek reasonable and mutually satisfactory resolution of the zoning and lease issues related to the operation of the agency at this site, and

WHEREAS, the Task Force has recommended a Tahoma/Raven Heights Communities Plan Amendment Study as a solution to recognize existing uses and to allow expansion of senior programs, public health services, youth and family services, or the introduction of new uses, and

WHEREAS, the Tahoma/Raven Heights planning area was the second fastest growing planning area in the period 1990-1992 (increase of 10.5% in the unincorporated portion), and

WHEREAS, demand for the Maple Valley Community Center services is anticipated to increase as build-out occurs, and

WHEREAS, the 1985 King County Comprehensive Plan encourages provision of adequate public facilities and
