4 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to submit
5 proposals for funding of employment and training programs
6 to the Seattle-King County Private Industry Council.

7 WHEREAS, King County has a commitment to provide employment and training
8 services to vulnerable residents, and

9 WHEREAS, the federal Job Partnership Training Act through the Seattle-King
10 County Private Industry Council provides an avenue of available funding for King
11 County's use in honoring that commitment, and

12 WHEREAS, King County has been advised by the Seattle-King County Private
13 Industry Council that 1994 funds will be targeted to high-poverty communities;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

15 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to apply for federal Job
16 Training Partnership Act funding in the approximate amount of \$2,269,130 from the
17 Seattle-King County Private Industry Council for the period July 1, 1994 to June 30,
18 1995.

19 B. The King County executive is authorized to enter into such contracts as may be
20 required by the Private Industry Council.
