2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant  
3 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$207,114 to  
4 support a Fair Housing Incentive Program, Grant File No.  
5 352/6209.

6 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development is  
7 empowered to make grants to support Fair Housing Incentive Programs, and

8 WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Assistance Program will assist the county in enforcing  
9 its direction and in increasing public awareness of Fair Housing legislation affecting residents  
10 of King County, and

11 WHEREAS, the provision of such services is in the public interest;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

13 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application, substantially  
14 in the form attached, for funds in the approximate amount of \$207,114 to the U. S. Department  
15 of Housing and Urban Development for the Fair Housing Incentive Program, on behalf of  
16 King County;

17 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such  
18 application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

19 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such  
20 subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
