5 A MOTION authorizing the expenditure of \$200,677 from
6 the Superior Court Security Fund for the purpose of
7 funding equipment and supplies for 1994 security
8 enhancements.

9 WHEREAS, King County has recognized the need to achieve the goal of safety basic to
10 the process of justice, and

11 WHEREAS, security is a common concern to all courts, court related agencies, and other
12 departments and agencies occupying the courthouse, and

13 WHEREAS, in the 1991 budget, the King County Council appropriated \$315,000 in CIP
14 Project 666527 for the purpose of improving courthouse security, and

15 WHEREAS, per a 1991 budget proviso, no funds shall be expended on the Superior Court
16 Security Project until the council approves a scope of work for the project, and

17 WHEREAS, the King County Superior Court and the Interbranch Committee on Court
18 Security recommends that court security be expanded to implement the provisions of RCW
19 9.41.300 as amended by Chapter 396 Laws of Washington, 1993 regarding the prohibition of
20 weapons in court facilities, and

21 WHEREAS, the King County Superior Court has been authorized to hire personnel to
22 expand security, and

23 WHEREAS, equipment and supplies are necessary to provide adequate security,

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of Metropolitan King County:

25 The scope of work contained in Attachment A is approved to spend \$200,677 from the
26 Superior Court Security Fund for security equipment and supplies.
