A MOTION endorsing the plan for the Demonstration Drug Diversion Court as submitted by the King County Executive, Superior Court and the King County Prosecuting Attorney.

WHEREAS, drug diversion courts are a new and promising approach in treating drug-involved defendants through encouraging defendants to participate in treatment instead of the traditional prosecution and incarceration, and

WHEREAS, the Demonstration Drug Diversion Court Plan submitted by the superior court, the prosecuting attorney and the King County executive demonstrates a viable approach for implementing a drug diversion court in King County, and

WHEREAS, the superior court, prosecuting attorney and King County executive desire council approval of this plan prior to appropriation of funding to implement this program

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County council hereby endorses the Drug Diversion Court Plan as submitted by the superior court, the prosecuting attorney and the county executive.
