A MOTION regarding compliance with the requirements of RCW 42.41, and requesting the King County executive to post information on the right to report improper governmental actions and the remedies available for employees suffering retaliation for so doing.

WHEREAS, the State legislature has enacted, and the governor signed into law, RCW 42.41, which specifies the right of local government employees to report improper governmental actions and to be free from acts of retaliation for so doing, and

WHEREAS, RCW 42.41, among its other provisions, requires that employees be informed of their right to report improper governmental action, to whom they may report such actions, and the procedures to be used to seek relief from acts of retaliation for so reporting, and

WHEREAS, King County government is required to comply with the provisions of RCW 42.41, and

WHEREAS, compliance with the provisions of RCW 42.41 has not yet occurred;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is requested to expeditiously meet the requirements stated in RCW 42.41 by immediately posting in places readily accessible to all King County

1 employees information regarding the right of King County
2 employees to report improper governmental actions, to whom
3 such actions may be reported and the process to be used for
4 seeking relief from retaliation for so doing, as specified in
5 State law.
