2 A MOTION confirming Dec. 1, 1994 as the
3 deadline for review and recommendation by
4 the Regional Transit Committee on
5 proposed ordinance 94-709, and thanking
6 the Regional Transit Committee for
7 agreeing to complete its review by that
8 date.

9 WHEREAS, the Regional Transit Authority transmitted the
10 regional transit system plan to the Metropolitan King County
11 council on November 7, 1994, and

12 WHEREAS, under the provisions of RCW 81.112.030(6), the
13 Metropolitan King County council has 45 days following
14 receipt of the plan to confirm or rescind its continued
15 participation in the Regional Transit Authority, and

16 WHEREAS, proposed ordinance 94-709 regarding continued
17 participation in the Regional Transit Authority has been
18 referred to the Regional Transit Committee for review and
19 recommendation, and

20 WHEREAS, under the provisions of King County Charter
21 Section 270.30, the Regional Transit Committee and the
22 Metropolitan King County Council may jointly establish a time
23 limit other than 120 days for review of the proposed plan,
24 and

25 WHEREAS, the Regional Transit Committee agreed at its
26 meeting of November 3, 1994 to complete its review of and
27 recommendation on the Regional Transit Authority system plan
28 on December 1, 1994, and

29 WHEREAS, the Regional Transit Committee will work with
30 the Transportation, Transit and Regional Governance Committee
31 by holding a joint meeting on December 1, 1994;

1 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King
2 County:

3 The deadline for review and recommendation by the
4 Regional Transit Committee of proposed ordinance 94-709 is
5 confirmed as December 1, 1994.

6 The Metropolitan King County council thanks the Regional
7 Transit Committee for agreeing to complete committee review
8 and recommendation by December 1, 1994 in order to meet the
9 statutory requirement for Metropolitan King County council
10 action.

11 The Metropolitan King County council also acknowledges
12 the joint effort of the Regional Transit Committee and the
13 Transportation, Transit and Regional Governance Committee in
14 the review of the plan.
