A MOTION creating a task force to prepare an extension of the King County Domestic Violence Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, in 1988 King County approved a five-year domestic violence comprehensive plan, calling for improved coordination of community and law enforcement agencies, and

WHEREAS, as a result of this plan, King County began successfully addressing the problem of domestic violence in a coordinated manner, and

WHEREAS, the King County Comprehensive Plan needs to be extended, providing the county with a clear direction for the next five years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The county council hereby directs the county executive to establish a task force, hereafter known as the King County Domestic Violence Coordinating Committee, co-chaired by the department of judicial administration and the department of human services, to develop a five-year extension of the current King County Domestic Violence Comprehensive Plan. The King County Domestic Violence Coordinating Committee will include a representative of the King County Council.

B. The county council hereby states its intent that all requests for funding relating to domestic violence will be reviewed by the King County Domestic Violence Coordinating Committee for compliance with the King County Domestic Violence Comprehensive Plan.

C. The county council hereby requests the county executive to submit to the council the extension of the King County Domestic Violence Comprehensive Plan by June 30, 1995.
