

I helped write a policy for the K.C. Comp which promotes integrated planning for surface water, wastewater, groundwater and drinking water in future watershed plans.

I believe the methodology and acquisition of baseline water quality data are presently deficient.

I believe we need to better educate the public about uses of recycled (tertiary treated water) and using Lake Washington

Many of our water quality problems are solvable - we have only begun to try some of the creative solutions to water supply and quality problems that have been successful.

Especially the existing policies of treating waste water as something that must be centrally collected and disposed of (directly into Puget Sound) may be obsolete as opportunities for silviculture and agriculture increase demand for precious surface supplies.


