- Briefly describe what water quality issues in King County are of concern and importance to you.

Wasting water is a primary concern of mine. I would like to teach people to conserve water at home and at their work place. In addition I would like to see innovations in plumbing to reuse water. For instance, it would be great to have 2 drains in the kitchen sink - one that goes to the sewer and another that goes to a storage tank. Water that is used to wash vegetables or relatively clean dishes could go to a storage tank where it would be used in toilets or for watering plants. I applaud Metro's plans to use recycled water for watering golf courses and landscaped areas and for other uses that don't require potable water.

- Why do you wish to be a member of CWQAC? Please share any additional information about your interest and/or experience with these issues.

I've always been interested in using things wisely - i.e. buying quality that lasts a long time. I abhor our "throw away" society. Because so many people have moved to Seattle we need to conserve and reuse our water. I've ~~always~~ been impressed with Metro's programs such as ~~the~~ using biosolids to fertilize forests. I would like to be involved in the new program to treat effluent for nonpotable use. I think that I could be useful to the committee by understanding technical aspects of the program and helping to explain them in nontechnical terms to people without a technical or scientific background.
