**COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE 1994 WORK PROGRAM  
ADDITIONAL COUNCIL REQUESTED PROJECT**

- **Capacity Charge for Sewage Facilities**
  - 1) Review the capacity charge assessed by the water quality program on users of the metropolitan municipal corporation's sewage facilities when the user connects or establishes a new service, and 2) determine whether charges have been collected and spent for water quality program capital improvements in accordance with state law.
