A MOTION adopting the 1995 King County Emergency
Medical Services Master Plan Update.

WHEREAS, the King County emergency medical services system is a partnership of
King County, cities, fire districts, private ambulance providers, hospitals, and others, and

WHEREAS, these agencies have cooperated in a comprehensive emergency medical
services master planning process, and

WHEREAS, the emergency medical services master plan has been periodically
updated in order to make recommendations regarding workload projections, use rates, the need
and location of additional services, and other related operational needs, and

WHEREAS the King County council requested the development of emergency
medical service system performance indicators to assist in planning and providing cost-
effective services; and

WHEREAS, the 1995 emergency medical services master plan makes
recommendations for emergency medical services system indicators, evaluates the current
status of the regional emergency medical services system, and identifies areas for further
service improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The 1995 emergency medical services master plan update is hereby adopted

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B. The King County council further requests the King County executive to proceed with carrying out, in cooperation with local cities, fire districts, hospitals and other agencies the recommendations regarding injury prevention, E-911 and dispatch, basic life support services, and advanced life support services.
