A MOTION authorizing King County to accept a contribution of equipment to assist in the automation efforts of the Superior Court Ex Parte Department.

WHEREAS, King County provides guardianship services to persons in alleged incompetency cases, and

WHEREAS, a list of available and certified guardians must be maintained by Superior Court's Ex Parte department, and

WHEREAS, the King County Superior Court has received a contribution of equipment to the Ex Parte department to assist in maintaining these lists, and

WHEREAS, King County Superior Court accepts the responsibility for operating and maintaining the computer equipment given by the King County Bar Association, and

WHEREAS, King County Code, Section 2.80 requires that gifts, bequests and donations shall be accepted on behalf of King County by motion of the King County council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

King County is hereby authorized to accept a contribution of a personal computer, monitor and printer, valued at approximately \$2,181, for the Superior Court Ex Parte department.
