A MOTION authorizing King County to accept a donation to provide funds for staffing support for the Unified Family Court Task Force.

WHEREAS, King County provides services to youth and families, and the Unified Family Court concept is a part of those services, and

WHEREAS, the development of the Unified Family Court has necessitated the reassignment of Superior Court personnel to assist the Court to temporarily further the development of the concept, and

WHEREAS, the planning effort for Unified Family Court has been conducted by a Bench/Bar Task Force since 1993, and

WHEREAS, the task force continues to investigate specific issues related to implementing Unified Family Court recommendations arising from Phase I, and

WHEREAS, the King County Superior Court has received a contribution in the amount of \$3,784 to contribute to staff costs for this effort;

WHEREAS, King County Code, Section 2.80 requires that gifts, bequests and donations shall be accepted on behalf of King County by motion of the King County council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

King County is hereby authorized to accept a contribution in the amount of \$3,784 to defray staff costs for the Unified Family Court Task Force.

PASSED by a vote of 9 to 0 this 11<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1995.
