A MOTION requesting the county executive to enter into an agreement with the City of Seattle amending the Shoreline Improvement Fund Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (METRO) and the City of Seattle have entered into a Shoreline Improvement Fund Agreement dated January 28, 1991, and

WHEREAS, to compensate for unavoidable impacts in communities affected by West Point and Alki construction, said agreement provides for a \$2 million fund for improvements to neighborhoods affected by Metro's West Point and Alki construction projects, and

WHEREAS, the Magnolia neighborhood has submitted a proposal to the city of Seattle that a portion of this fund be used to construct, operate and maintain a public swimming pool to mitigate some of the impacts caused by the West Point and Alki construction projects, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Shoreline Improvement Fund Agreement precludes the use of the Community Improvement Fund for the operation and maintenance of projects, and

WHEREAS, construction, operation and maintenance of the proposed public swimming pool will help mitigate for the impact caused by the West Point and Alki construction projects;
