3 Executive's compliance with the terms
4 of a 1995 budget proviso relating to
5 interim safety improvements on 228th
6 Avenue SE

8 WHEREAS, by means of ordinance 11578, the council
9 appropriated funds for major improvements to 228th Avenue SE,
10 and

11 WHEREAS, expenditure after September 1, 1995 of funds
12 appropriated for this project was made contingent upon
13 interim safety improvements to several 228th Ave. SE
14 intersections or upon council approval of further
15 expenditures, and

16 WHEREAS, the Executive has responded to the proviso, in
17 a letter dated November 17, 1995, by describing plans for
18 interim safety improvements at the intersection of 228th Ave.
19 SE and SE 20th St., with construction beginning in November
20 of this year, and

21 WHEREAS, the Executive provided analysis of possible
22 interim safety improvements to the intersection of 228th Ave.
23 SE and SE 4th St. and concluded that, due to low accident
24 rates and left turn volumes, such improvements are neither
25 warranted nor cost-effective;
