4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE
5 PIERCE COUNTY COUNCIL APPOINTING Calvin Goings TO REPRESENT
6 LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT NO. 25 IN THE WASHINGTON STATE SENATE, FILLING THE
7 VACANCY LEFT BY THE RESIGNATION OF SENATOR MARCUS GASPARD.

8 WHEREAS, a vacancy has been created in the 25th Legislative
9 District, Washington State Senate, because of the resignation of
10 Senator Marcus Gaspard, a Democrat; and

11 WHEREAS, Legislative District No. 25 is a multi-jurisdictional
12 District located partly in King County and partly in Pierce County, and
13 the Washington State Constitution Article II, Section 15, provides that
14 in the event of a multi-jurisdiction vacancy, that the vacancy shall be
15 filled by joint action of the Boards; and

16 WHEREAS, the Washington State Democratic Central Committee has
17 submitted the names of three qualified nominees for the Senate vacancy
18 who are to be considered by the Metropolitan King County Council and
19 the Pierce County Council, and the two Councils have met in a joint
20 special meeting and have interviewed the nominees; NOW THEREFORE,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE METROPOLITAN KING COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE
22 PIERCE COUNTY COUNCIL:

23 Section 1. Calvin Goings is one of the three nominees
24 recommended by the Washington State Democratic Central Committee, and
25 is qualified to fill the Senate vacancy representing District No. 25.

26 Section 2. Calvin Goings is hereby appointed to the
27 Washington State Senate, Legislative District No. 25, to fill the
28 vacancy created by the resignation of Senator Marcus Gaspard.
