14 WHEREAS, King County's comprehensive plan policy ED-302
15 recognizes King County governments' leadership role in
16 efforts to provide training and educational programs that
17 will create a globally competitive workforce, and

18 WHEREAS, efforts to meet training and educational needs
19 can be facilitated on a countywide basis by implementing
20 programs to create a skilled workforce, and

21 WHEREAS, the Occupational Skills Center, and the South
22 Duwamish Industrial Training Center goal is to develop job
23 preparation and life skills for its students, and

24 WHEREAS, students who attend these centers are trained
25 in construction, home repair and remodeling, boat repair and
26 manufacturing, automotive repair, computer-aided design, and
