MOTION NO. **10042**

A MOTION authorizing free disposal of storm-related debris resulting from the storm that began December 26, 1996.

WHEREAS, King County experienced an unusually destructive storm beginning December 26, 1996, causing significant damage to homes and other property, and

WHEREAS, disposal of waste material resulting from the storm at normal disposal fees would cause financial hardship for many property owners, and

WHEREAS, all of King County will benefit from the cleanup of damage caused by the storm, and

WHEREAS, the executive, on January 2, 1997, called for waived fees for the disposal of storm-related debris at County transfer stations on Sunday, January 5, Saturday, January 11, and Sunday, January 12, 1997 and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.C.C. 10.12.050B, actions taken by the executive to waive fees that continue beyond the date of the next regularly scheduled council meeting require council approval by motion for continuation; and

WHEREAS, the waiver called for by the Executive will continue past the next regularly scheduled council meeting (January 6, 1997) following the Executive's January 2, 1997 declaration; and

1 WHEREAS, additional opportunities for disposal of storm-related
2 debris may be needed, and the Executive is continuing to evaluate whether
3 such needs require further emergency action beyond January 12, 1997;

4 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

5 A. The King County council hereby authorizes the Executive to
6 eliminate solid waste disposal fees for residential customers for storm-
7 related debris related to damage from the storm which begin December 26,
8 1996.

9 B. The council confirms the action of the executive to authorize
10 such disposal on January 5, 11 and 12, 1997, and such additional dates as
11 shall be approved by the utilities and natural resources committee. The
12 executive shall report to the utilities and natural resources committee on
13 January 9, 1997 regarding collection activities, and the need to continue
14 the disposal fee waiver beyond the time periods specified herein.
