3 statement for the November 4, 1997 general election regarding
4 Ordinance 12852 proposing amendments to the King County Charter
5 relating to qualifications for county officers; revising the age to hold
6 county office to the age of the eligibility to vote; amending section
7 630 of Article 6 of the Charter; and submitting the same to the voters
8 of the county for their ratification or rejection at the November 1997
9 general election.

11 WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10, as amended, provides for the publication and distribution of local
12 voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for annual general
13 elections held in King County, and

14 WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is
15 included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally
16 appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a
17 committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

18 WHEREAS, Ordinance 12852 provides for submission to the voters on November 4, 1997 a
19 proposition to amend the King County Charter regarding qualifications for county officers and
20 revising the age to hold county office to the age of the eligibility to vote and submitting the same to
21 the voters of the county for their ratification or rejection at the November 1997 general election;
