12 WHEREAS, the division of records and elections has contacted these jurisdictions
13 regarding the possibility of inclusion in the county-wide local voters pamphlet, and

14 WHEREAS, some jurisdictions have indicated interest in being included in this
15 pamphlet, and

16 WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.020 permits local government units to enter into
17 interlocal agreements with the county to appear in a local voters pamphlet prepared by the
