**COUNTY AUDITOR'S OFFICE 1998 WORK PROGRAM
ADDITIONAL COUNCIL REQUESTED PROJECT**

- **King Conservation District**

Review the financial condition of the Conservation District; determine the agency's ability to complete the work plan adopted by Council ordinance 12959; inventory the number of farm management plans completed to date and evaluate the Conservation District's ability to complete all of the farm management plans before December 31, 1998; determine whether the Conservation District is diverting resources from local jurisdictions or Regional Needs Assessment Funds to sustain District operations; and determine whether or not expenditures by watershed forums and cities are proper and are being handled in an accountable manner.
