
A MOTION confirming the executive's appointment of Art Louie, who resides in council district eight, to the King County transit advisory committee.

BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The county executive's appointment of Art Louie, who resides in council district eight, to the King County transit advisory committee, term to expire on September 30, 2000, is hereby confirmed.

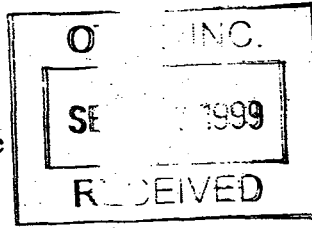

Confidentiality: Pursuant to K.C.C. 3.04.110, the statements of elected officials, candidates for county elective office, department directors, division managers, the deputy county executive, and the county executive's administrative assistants are public record. All other statements shall not be made public without the *written approval* of the Board of Ethics. The Board of Ethics will not release these statements without prior notification and after deleting Privacy Act information.
