A MOTION authorizing the executive finance committee to approve interim interfund borrowing for parks ballfields initiative, CIP project 316280.

WHEREAS, the executive has responded to council's 2000 budget proviso requesting a report assessing the pros, cons and uncertainties of issuing 20-year LTGO bonds, that would repaid from REET 2 revenues, to partially fund the parks ballfields initiative, CIP project 316280, and

WHEREAS, before any potential bond sale, funding of four million two hundred thousand dollars is required to keep the ballfields initiative project on schedule, and

WHEREAS, the King County council stated in the 2000 budget proviso its intent to provide 2000 funding for the project in a 2000 LTGO bond issuance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

The executive finance committee is hereby authorized to provide interim funding in the form of an interfund loan, of approximately four million two hundred thousand dollars, to parks CIP project 316280, to continue design and construction on the ballfields

initiative project.
