A MOTION requesting the executive to forward to the council, by January 31, 2001, an environmental impact mitigation credit program for capital improvement projects and a plan for the use of the King County Shinglemill Creek Mitigation Site Pilot Project. WHEREAS, King County continually seeks to develop innovative and costeffective strategies to conserve the environment, including the mitigation of impacts caused by construction or maintenance of capital facilities, and WHEREAS, King County is regularly required by county, state and federal agencies to provide mitigation for capital improvement project environmental impacts, including incursions into parks, open spaces, habitat corridors, salmonid habitat, riparian zones, agricultural lands, groundwater recharge areas and other environmentally sensitive areas, and

WHEREAS, environmental impact mitigation is typically accomplished through
replacement or reconstruction of environmentally impacted areas, and

19	WHEREAS, mitigation credit may be accomplished through acquisition of critical
20	habitat, riparian lands, wetlands, greenspaces and sensitive areas that could be lost or
21 .	degraded through development or other land use practices, and
22	WHEREAS, acquisition of threatened resource lands may, in certain cases,
23	provide a more efficient and cost-effective way to protect natural resources than other
24	mitigation actions, and
25	WHEREAS, such mitigation will also help King County meet certain
26	environmental protection goals of the state of Washington growth management act, the
27	federal Endangered Species Act and other related county comprehensive plan and
28	environmental protection policies.
29	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
30	The executive is requested to forward to the council, by January 31, 2001, a
31	mitigation credit program to address environmental impacts resulting from King County
32	capital improvement projects. The proposal shall include a plan for the use of the King

County Shinglemill Creek Mitigation Site Pilot Project located on Vashon Island.
