A MOTION appointing a committee to write the voters pamphlet statement for the September 19, 2000 primary election regarding Ordinance 13894 providing for the submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on September 19, 2000, of a proposition authorizing the continuation of a property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation contained in Chapter 84.55 RCW, for an additional five consecutive year period, at a rate of not more than \$0.05784 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation, for the purpose of paying for the continued operation of the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS).

WHEREAS, K.C.C. 1.10, as amended, provides for the publication and distribution of local voters pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 29.81A RCW for elections held in King County, and

WHEREAS, RCW 29.81A.080 provides that for each measure from a jurisdiction that is included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 13894 provides for the submission to the qualified electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on September 19, 2000, of a proposition authorizing the continuation of a property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation contained in Chapter 84.55 RCW, for an additional five consecutive year period, at a rate of not more than \$0.05784 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation, for the purpose of paying for the continued operation of the Automated Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS);


