16	that is included in a local voters pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction	
17	shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the	

18	measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure

21	electors of King County at a special election to be held in King County on November 7,
