13 range of complex issues, and

15 contractual requirement within the original contract with the county, and

16 WHEREAS, The Ferguson Group would provide the high level of expertise
17 needed to represent the county during the United States 107th Congress, 1st session, and

18 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


19 The chair of the Metropolitan King County Council is authorized to extend the a

23 county's behalf on issues, including but not limited to, agriculture, energy, transportation,
24 housing, water and sewer, and threatened and endangered species issues, during the
25 United States 107th Congress, 1st session.


