8 WHEREAS, transit/high occupancy vehicle (HOV) access across the Interstate 90
9 bridge uses the reversible center roadway westbound in the morning and eastbound in the
10 afternoon, and

11 WHEREAS, all-day two-way HOV access across I-90 is critical to the reliable
12 and efficient movement of Sound Transit and King County Metro buses, and

13 WHEREAS, the adopted regional transit plan, Sound Move, includes a project for
14 an Interstate-90 two-way center roadway, and

15 WHEREAS, Sound Transit has worked with its regional partners on the Mercer
16 Island Steering/I-90 Committee, which has identified four alternatives to achieve all-day
17 two-way transit/HOV access on the corridor. The four alternatives are: R-1, No-Build;


