1 A MOTION appointing members to the districting
2 committee in accordance with Section 650.30.20 of the
3 King County Charter.

6 WHEREAS, Section 650.30.30 of the King County Charter, Districting Plan,
7 provides for an independent county districting procedure, and

8

9 WHEREAS, Section 650.30.10 of the King County Charter provides that the
10 boundaries of each district shall correspond as nearly as practical with the boundaries of
11 the election precincts, municipalities and census tracts and shall be drawn to produce
12 districts with compact and contiguous territory, composed of economic and geographic
13 units and approximately equal in population, and

14 WHEREAS, The King County Charter provides that the council appoint two
15 persons representing each of the two major political parties, the four persons to appoint a
16 fifth person who shall serve as the chairman of the districting committee, and

16

17 WHEREAS, the redistricting process should be conducted in a manner that
ensures the public the opportunity for public participation;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 In accordance with Section 650.30.20 of the King County Charter, the following
20 persons are hereby appointed to represent the two major political parties on the districting
21 committee:

22 Democratic Party: 1. Wayne Ehlers

23 2. Michael Mann

24 Republican Party: 1. Mike Patrick

25 2. Connie Marshall

26 The districting committee is requested to conduct its business according to the
27 standards of the Open Public Meetings Act and to conduct at least one public hearing
28 before adopting the districting plan.
