WHEREAS, the King County sheriff's office owns surplus and unusable items
7 such as obsolete uniforms, bulletproof vests, badges, patches and other miscellaneous
8 equipment of little or no monetary value, and

WHEREAS, the items for donation would normally be destroyed or sold in bulk
at an auction to lower administrative costs and separating them out for separate auctions
11 would not be cost effective for the county, and

WHEREAS, the items for donation would be of notable historical value which
would promote, document, demonstrate and depict the history, culture and technological
14 transitions of the King County sheriff's office, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle Metropolitan Police Museum's mission is to collect,
16 preserve and exhibit artifacts and archival material significant to the history of law
17 enforcement in Seattle and King County, and

18 WHEREAS, the Seattle, Metropolitan Police Museum has expressed an interest in
19 the addition of items to their collection and would enable all citizens in King County to
20 appreciate King County's law enforcement history;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:



Motion 11167 was introduced on 2/26/01 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 4/16/01, by the following vote:


