A MOTION requesting the King County Department of Transportation to submit a contingency plan for transit 2 service affected by earthquake damage to the Alaskan Way 3 Viaduct. 4 5 6 7 WHEREAS, the Alaskan Way Viaduct has for many years been a key transit corridor providing a reliable, express connection between the downtown and West 8 9 Seattle, and WHEREAS, King County Metro Transit buses are unable to use the viaduct due 10 11 to structural damage sustained in the February 28, 2001, earthquake, and 12 WHEREAS, the former viaduct bus routes now operating on surface streets are 13 substantially slower and less reliable, especially during Safeco Field events, 14 inconveniencing riders and causing delays so great that individual trips have been

16	WHEREAS, the interim option of adding buses to the affected routes could
17	improve the reliability, but at a substantial cost while failing to address the travel time
18	increases experienced by riders, and
19	WHEREAS, these impacts affect not only West Seattle but also neighborhoods to
20	the north of downtown served by routes that connect with the former viaduct routes, and
21	WHEREAS, the Washington state Department of Transportation (WSDOT)
22	cannot currently say whether buses will be permitted to return to the viaduct once the
23	structural repairs now underway are completed, and
24	WHEREAS, a recent WSDOT report from a team of structural experts identified
25	long-term concerns over the viaduct's ability to withstand another major earthquake, the
26	current repairs notwithstanding;
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
28	The King County department of transportation is requested to transmit a
29	contingency plan to the council by August 1, 2001, to address the possibility that buses
30	will not be permitted to resume using the Alaskan Way Viaduct following completion of

the repair work currently under way. The plan should include a consideration of options and a recommendation for returning the affected routes to their prior performance levels.
