12 public benefits, and

 WHEREAS, high quality passenger vans retaining substantial value and utility are
14 periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and

 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred
16 retired vans to agencies serving low-income, elderly, disabled and young people, and

17 WHEREAS, the council provided for the transfer of twenty-six additional vans in
18 the 2001 Metro transit division budget;




