	Proposed No. 2001-0536.1 Sponsors Sullivan
1	A MOTION requesting the United States Congress to include
2	within a national economic stimulus package a temporary increase
3	in the Medicaid Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP);
4	providing states additional funds to cover the costs of increased
5	Medicaid enrollment resulting from a downturn in the economy.
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8	WHEREAS, The Medicaid financing system is designed so states and the federal
9	government jointly cover the costs of health insurance for low-income people, and
10	WHEREAS, despite the economic downturn affecting Washington State, the
11	federal Medicaid matching rate for Washington is slated to decrease by 0.33 percent to
12	50.37 percent, causing a reduction of eighteen million five hundred thousand dollars in
13	federal funds to the state of Washington in Fiscal Year 2002, and
14	WHEREAS, local unemployment is expected to increase as Boeing, one of King
15	county's largest employers is scheduled to lay off thirty thousand employees, and

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16	WHEREAS, Washington state's Medicaid expenditures will likely rise more
17	rapidly than had earlier been anticipated as more workers are laid off and their families
18	become income eligible for Medicaid, and
19	WHEREAS, Governor Gary Locke has directed the state of Washington's
20	Department of Social and Health Services to reduce their budget by four hundred seventy
21	million dollars to account for a loss in state revenues due to a slumping local economy,
22	and
23	WHEREAS, each percentage point increase in the federal Medicaid matching rate
24	will generate approximately fifty-five million dollars per year to the state of Washington,
25	bolstering state health insurance programs, freeing up state funds otherwise needed for
26	Medicaid and helping to avoid cuts in other budget areas, including areas affecting
27	counties and local communities such as public health and treatment for mentally ill and
28	chemically dependent persons, and
29	WHEREAS, a temporary increase in the Medicaid Federal Medical Assistance
30	Percentage is one of the highest legislative priorities of the National Governors
31	Association, and
32	WHEREAS, Congress is in the process of considering an economic stimulus
33	package;
34	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
35	The King County council respectfully requests that Congress include in any

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36 national economic stimulus package an increase in the Medicaid Federal Medical

37 Assistance Percentage.
