1	A MOTION declaring the intent of the King County
2	council to explore establishing a sister county relationship
3.	with Granma, Cuba.

6	WHEREAS, it is in the interest of King County to expand international relations
7	with counties and provinces in other nations that offer opportunities for cultural, social,
8	educational and economic enrichment of the citizens of King County, and
9	WHEREAS, the people of King County travel the world extensively and have a
10	strong tradition of building economic and cultural ties with the people of other nations,
11 .	and
12	WHEREAS, throughout the United States economic and policy institutions such
13	as the United States Chamber of Commerce and the Unite States Council on Foreign
14	Relations have supported expanding economic ties with Cuba, and
15	WHEREAS, United States government bodies, including the state of
16	Pennsylvania and eight United States cities, including the city of Tacoma, have
17	established sister jurisdiction relationships with similar governments in Cuba, and

18	WHEREAS, last year an estimated one hundred forty thousand Americans,
19	including some three thousand four hundred businesses representatives traveled to Cuba,
20	and
21	WHEREAS King County universities and colleges would benefit from academic
22 -	exchanges with their Cuban counterparts involving faculty, administrators and students,
23	and
24	WHEREAS King County has established sister county relationships with
25	Kaohsiung County in the Republic of China and Hwasong County in the Republic of
26	Korea, and
27	WHEREAS, the official leadership of Granma Province, Cuba, has expressed a
28	strong interest in establishing a sister county relationship with King County, and
29	WHEREAS, Granma Province officials have invited a delegation of King County
30	officials, community and business leaders to visit Granma to explore the desirability of
31	establishing a sister county relationship, and
32	WHEREAS, Granma Province is similar in size to King County, is situated on a
33	salt water bay with mountainous regions and is home to eight hundred thousand residents
34	and
35	WHEREAS, King County is one of the most successful exporting regions in the
36	Unites States, making significant positive contributions to the United States's balance of
37	payments account, while providing thousands of jobs to King County residents, and
38	WHEREAS, to remain vibrant, the King County economy requires strong
39	international export markets for the sales of goods and services;
40	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The metropolitan King County council endorses and supports exploratory efforts to establish a sister county relationship with Granma Province, Cuba.
