1           A MOTION related to the transfer of retired vanpool vans  
2           to non-profit organizations and local governments to meet  
3           the needs of low-income, elderly, disabled and young  
4           county citizens.

7           WHEREAS, King County provides transit services to its citizens to increase  
8           mobility options, reduce traffic congestion and related environmental degradation, and

9           WHEREAS, the provision of passenger vans to groups serving individuals with  
10          limited resources and mobility options will support those goals and provide significant  
11          public benefits, and

12          WHEREAS, high-quality passenger vans retaining substantial value and utility  
13          are periodically retired from the county's vanpool program, and

14          WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has previously transferred  
15          retired vans to agencies serving low-income, elderly, disabled and young people, and

16          WHEREAS, the council provided for the transfer of twenty-six additional vans in  
17          the 2002 Metro transit division budget, and

18           WHEREAS, a recent shift in the retirement policy for vanpool fleet vehicles from  
19           five years to six years combined with no van purchase in 1996 has resulted in the  
20           availability of only thirteen vans for distribution by the council this year;

21           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22           The donation of a retired vanpool passenger van to each of the following agencies  
23           is hereby approved:

24           ARC of King County;

25           Black Diamond Community Center;

26           Burien Highline Senior Center;

27           CYE Learning Center;

28           Federal Way Boys and Girls Club;

29           Friendship House;

30           Fremont Public Association;

31           Hale Halawai O Hawai'i;

33           North Seattle Boys and Girls Club;




Motion 11582 was introduced on 9/30/2002 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 10/14/2002, by the following vote:
