8           WHEREAS, King County department of judicial administration ("DJA") is  
9           conducting a statewide Elder Abuse Conference to train law enforcement and prosecutors  
10          on recognizing and responding to elder abuse, and

11          WHEREAS, the American Association of Retired Persons, a private organization  
12          with no contractual obligations with the county, has a vested interest in educating law  
13          enforcement on the serious issue of elder abuse, and

14          WHEREAS, The American Association of Retired Persons voluntarily, without  
15          coercion or inducement, wished to donate five thousand dollars to the Elder Abuse  
16          Conference, and

17           WHEREAS, this donation will legitimately enhance the county's ability to serve  
18           in the public's interest and the knowledge gained at the conference by attendees will  
19           benefit the elderly throughout Washington state, and

20           WHEREAS, this donation is intended neither to influence a particular county  
21           action, nor to affect the performance of official duties and DJA staff, and

22           WHEREAS, King County government is a charitable organization as defined by  
23           the federal Internal Revenue Service and King County as an entity can accept gifts;




