8 WHEREAS, the King County department of judicial administration ("DJA") is
9 conducting a statewide Elder Abuse Conference to train law enforcement and prosecutors
10 on recognizing and responding to elder abuse, and

11 WHEREAS, the Service Employees International Union Local Union 519 for
12 Public Employees ("SEIU Local 519"), a private entity with no contractual obligations
13 with the DJA, has a vested interest in educating law enforcement on the serious issue of
14 elder abuse, and

15 WHEREAS, SEIU Local 519 voluntarily, without coercion or inducement,
16 wished to donate one thousand dollars to the Elder Abuse Conference, and

17 WHEREAS, this donation will legitimately enhance the county's ability to serve
18 in the public's interest and the knowledge gained at the conference by attendees will
19 benefit the elderly throughout Washington state, and

20 WHEREAS, this donation is intended neither to influence a particular county
21 action, nor to affect the performance of official duties and responsibilities by the DJA
22 staff, and

23 WHEREAS, King County government is a charitable organization as defined by
24 the federal Internal Revenue Service and King County as an entity can accept gifts;

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 The King County department of judicial administration is authorized to accept a




