WHEREAS, in Ordinance 14711 the metropolitan King County council  
7 established the King County citizens' election oversight committee ("CEOC"), and

8

WHEREAS, the CEOC reviewed the conduct of the 2002 and 2003 elections in  
9 King County, identifying problems and making recommendations, and

WHEREAS, the CEOC expired after it made its report to the council, and

11

WHEREAS, further problems occurred in the 2004 general election and in the  
12 spring special election in 2005, and

13

WHEREAS, the council values the previous hard work of the CEOC members  
14 and in Ordinance 15157 established a new CEOC to review the 2004 general election and  
15 the spring special election, and

WHEREAS, Peter Abbarno, appointed in accordance with Motion 12117,  
17 resigned as the representative from the state Republican Party;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 Motion 12117 is hereby rescinded.

20 The following persons are appointed to the King County citizens' election  
21 oversight committee:

22 A. AJ Culver as the representative of a nonpartisan organization active in King  
23 County that evaluates candidates and ballot measures;

24 B. Joan Thomas as a representative from a nonpartisan organization active in

27 D. Gurine Nordby as representative from the King County Democratic Party;

28 E. Monica Tracey as a representative from the King County Republican Party;

29 F. Michael Snyder as a representative from the Washington state Democratic  
30 Party;

31 G. Michael Sheridan as a representative from the Washington state Republican  
32 Party;

33 H. Randy Matheson as a representative from a junior taxing district;

34 I. Sheryl Moss as an ex officio, nonvoting representative from the Office of the  
35 Secretary of State;

36 J. Paul Guppy as a representative of an independent research and policy institute;


