Patterson, Gossett and Dunn A MOTION creating the King County financial policies 1 2 advisory task force. 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council has a long history of 6 responsibly stewarding the public's money very seriously, and WHEREAS, the council passed Motion 5888 in December 1983, which created a 7 8 number of financial policies including a requirement for maintenance of minimum levels 9 of fund balance in the county's current expense fund, and 10 WHEREAS, the council passed Motion 7020 in November 1987, which dedicated 11 a portion of additional sales tax revenues to the creation of a sales tax reserve to be used 12 for financial emergencies, and 13 WHEREAS, the council passed Motion 8352 in July 1991, which reaffirmed its 14 intent that the sales tax reserve be used for financial emergencies, and 15 WHEREAS, the executive's proposed financial plan for 1992 proposed spending 16 the sales tax reserve funds, and

17	WHEREAS, in response, the council passed Motion 8446 in October 1991, once
18	again affirming its intent that the sales tax reserves only be used in financial emergencies,
19	and
20	WHEREAS, on July 5, 2000, the council adopted Motion 11196 enacting the
21	King County General Fund Debt Policy, outlining practices for the issuance and
22	management of debt and requiring biannual review of those enacted policies, and
23	WHEREAS, the county executive has not convened the board to review these
24	debt policies, and
25	WHEREAS, these sound financial policies have led the major credit rating
26	agencies to award the county's limited tax obligation debt with triple A ratings, and
27	WHEREAS, these financial and debt policies have not been formally reviewed
28	since 2000, and
29	WHEREAS, the council seeks to enact and maintain standard and rational
30	financial and debt policies for all funds that continue to ensure the lowest borrowing rates
31	possible resulting from exceptional credit-worthiness through exemplary bond ratings,
32	and
33	WHEREAS, the council strongly supports transparent and open government, and
34	citizen involvement, and
35	WHEREAS, the county's general policy is that "pay-as-you-go" funding is the
36	preferred method of financing for the county's capital improvement programs, and
37	WHEREAS, debt should be used in those circumstances where the investment is
38	necessary and cost effectiveness and cash flow circumstances require multiyear
39	financing;

40	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
41	A. A King County financial policies advisory task force is hereby created.
42	1. The metropolitan King County council shall appoint a five member advisory
43	panel to review the financial and debt policies of King County, in a priority order to be
44	set through a work program. Members shall be experts in the industry and shall be
45	selected based upon their knowledge of government budgeting and financial policies.
46	2. The task force shall review financial and debt policies previously adopted by
47	the metropolitan King County council as well as informal policies put into practice by
48	executive agencies; examine best practices in financial planning and make
49	recommendations to the council in each of these areas.
50	B. Nominations for appointments shall be provided to the council chair by
51	councilmembers by January 15, 2007. The chair of the council, in consultation with the
52	chairs of the operating and capital budget committees, or their successors, shall appoint
53	members, including a chair, by January 29, 2007.
54	C. The task force shall convene in the first quarter of 2007, and present a
55	prioritized work program to the council by March 15, 2007, with a final report due to the
56	council by August 20, 2007. Fifteen copies of these reports shall be filed with the clerk
57	of the council for distribution to all councilmembers and budget committee staff.
