



1	A MOTION appointing committees to write the voters'
2	pamphlet statements for and against King County Initiative
3	25 for the November 6, 2007, election.
4	
5	BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
6	A. K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of local
7	voters' pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29A.32 RCW for annual
8	general elections held in King County.
9	B. RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a unit of local
10	government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that
11	jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter
12	approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection
13	of the measure.
14	C. On August 22, 2007, the King County records, elections and licensing services
15	division issued a certificate of sufficiency for Initiative 25. The initiative places a
16	proposed ordinance on the ballot at the November 6, 2007, general election, which, if

17	passed, would submit a proposed King County Charter amendment to voters at the 2008	
18	general election that would create the elective office of county director of elections.	
19	D. The Initiative 25 sponsor, Toby Nixon, Chairman, Citizens for Accountable	
20	Elections, submitted the names of Toby Nixon, Susan Hutchinson and Sam Reed to serve	
21	on the pro Initiative 25 voters' pamphlet committee.	
22	E. In respect of the county initiative process and the Initiative 25 sponsor and	
23	supporters and pursuant to RCW 29A.32.280, the following individuals are appointed to	
24	serve on the voters' pamphlet committee to write a statement for the Initiative 25 ballot	
25	measure.	
26	F. This motion is solely to honor the request of the Initiative 25 sponsor to	
27	appoint members to serve on the voters' pamphlet committee to write a statement for the	
28	Initiative 25 ballot measure. This motion shall not be interpreted as an endorsement of	
29	Initiative 25.	
30	G. The county requests the executive to appoint members to serve on the voters'	
31	pamphlet committee to write a statement against the Initiative 25 ballot measure in time	
32	for its statement to be included in the state and local voters' pamphlet and to avoid the	
33	additional cost to the citizens of King County to produce a separate voters' pamphlet.
