1 A MOTION authorizing the chair of the council to enter
2 into a contract amendment extending the term of the
3 contract for services to represent the county with the
4 Washington state Legislature and specifying the
5 compensation to be paid during the extended term of the
6 contract.

8 WHEREAS, the county is a subdivision of the state of Washington, and
9 WHEREAS, as a result, the county's services, operations and finances are to a
10 significant extent controlled by the laws of the state, and

11 WHEREAS, legislation passed by the Washington state Legislature often impacts
12 King County's services, operations and finances, and

13 WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of King County to have
14 representation during the legislative session on a broad range of complex issues, and

15 WHEREAS, based on a competitive bidding process conducted in 2007, Michael
16 E. Temple was selected to represent King County with state government officials;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


18 The chair of the metropolitan King County council is authorized to enter into a
19 contract amendment extending the term of the contract with Michael E. Temple for the
20 services of monitoring actions by the state legislature and the state executive branch on
21 all issues of concern to King County, and to be an advocate on the county's behalf on all
22 issues, including, but not limited to, growth management, water and sewer, and
23 threatened and endangered species, for a one-year period, from August 28, 2008, to
24 August 29, 2009, for an amount not to exceed \$73,600 commencing with the date of
25 contract signature.

Motion 12819 was introduced on 7/7/2008 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 7/28/2008, by the following vote:


