1           A MOTION appointing committees to write the voters'  
2           pamphlet statements for and against the charter amendment  
3           placed on the ballot by Ordinance 16204 for the November  
4           4, 2008, election.

6           WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of  
7           local voters' pamphlets in conformity with the provisions of chapter 29A.32 RCW for  
8           annual general elections held in King County, and

9           WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides that for each measure from a unit of  
10          local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of  
11          that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating  
12          voter approval of the measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter  
13          rejection of the measure, and

14          WHEREAS, Ordinance 16204, passed by the council on July 14, 2008, provided  
15          for submission to the voters at the November 4, 2008, general election, of a proposed  
16          amendment to Section 840 of the King County Charter;

17          NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 Pursuant to RCW 29A.32.280, the following individuals are appointed to serve on  
19 the voters' pamphlet committees for the charter amendment proposed in Ordinance  
20 16204, each committee to write a statement for or against the proposed amendment, for  
21 the 2008 general election:

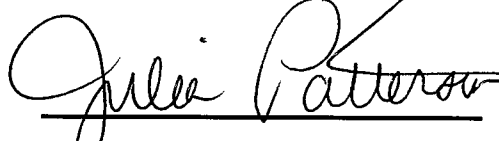
