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11	WHEREAS, in November 2007, the King County council approved provisos in
12	Ordinance 15975, requiring the office of management and budget and the accountable
13	business transformation ("ABT") program management office to provide to the council
14	by March 3, 2008, in writing, the proposed capital improvement program ("CIP")
15	reporting analysis requirement that will be included in ABT high level business design
16	for the budget system business functions, and subject to proviso P2 of Section 19, and
17	WHEREAS, the proviso further required the office of management and budget

18	and the ABT program management office to transmit to council a capital project report as
19	defined in the March 3, 2008, proviso response, and
20	WHEREAS the capital project report developed and transmitted herein according
21	to the terms of the applicable provisos in Ordinance 15975 represents only an interim step
22	toward the improvement of the capital project reporting structure developed
23	incrementally over twenty years, and
24	WHEREAS, the current capital reporting structure developed incrementally by
25	procedure, proviso, and the King County Code has resulted in multiple reporting
26	requirements which do not adequately meet the needs of either branch of government;
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
28	A. The King County council accepts the capital project report defined in the
<u>.</u> 9	proviso response transmitted on March 3, 2008.
80	B. The council, council auditor's office and executive staff should continue to
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work collaboratively to replace the existing capital project reporting structure in favor of a reporting structure designed to improve the value and timeliness of report content.
