10 WHEREAS, in Ordinance 15453, the council established a new citizens' elections
11 oversight committee and adopted criteria for membership on the committee;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


13 The appointment of Kim Wyman to the King County citizens' elections

County Council on 3/1/2010, by the following vote:


