10	WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of King County for the county to
11	have representation during the legislative session on a broad range of complex issues, and
12	WHEREAS, based on a competitive solicitation process, David Foster d/b/a
13	Foster Government Relations ("David Foster") was selected as the highest ranked
14	proposer and was chosen in 2012 to represent King County with state government
15	officials for a period of one year, with the possibility of extending the contract in one-

year increments for up to two additional periods for a total duration of three years, and

with Foster Government Relations for an additional year on the same terms and

WHEREAS, in 2013, the county exercised the option and extended the contract

20	WHEREAS, David Foster has been effectively representing King County with
21	state government officials during the past two years, and it would be in the county's best
22	interest to extend the contract with David Foster for the final additional year;

25	contract amendment, substantially in the form of Attachment A to this motion, extending
